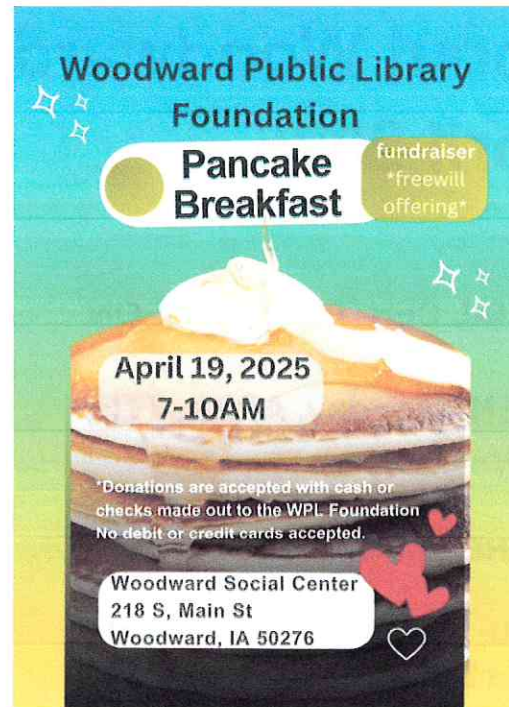

Fifteen new members were inducted into the National Honor Society on Thursday, March 27th.

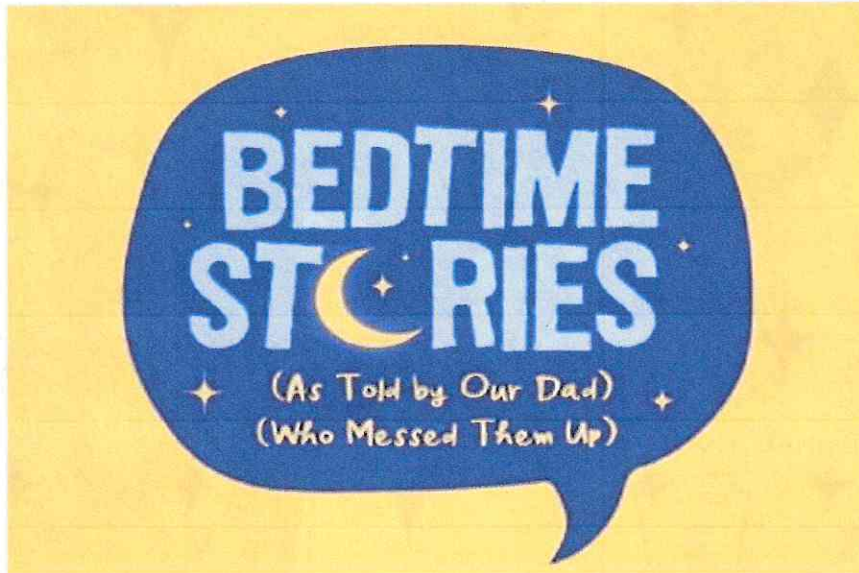

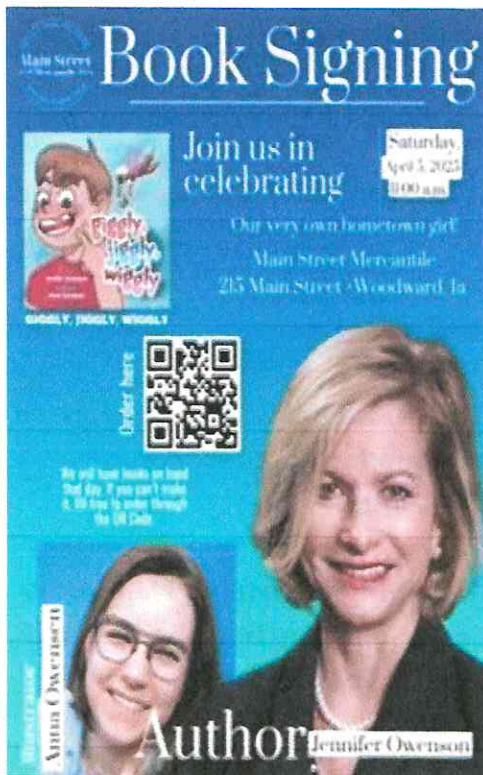

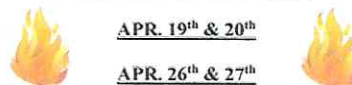
