

StoryWalk® Policy

A StoryWalk® is an innovative and delightful way for children – and adults – to enjoy stories in the great outdoors. Pages from a children’s book are hung or attached to wooden stakes along a path outdoors. As you stroll down the trail, you’ll go from page to page, enjoying the story along with a walk in nature.

Woodward Public Library’s StoryWalk® is located at the trailhead of High Trestle Trail. It is 16 posts—8 on the south side and 8 on the north side. A children’s story is placed in these posts each month as the weather permits. The stories are switched out around the 15th of each month. When the temperatures fall below 30° or the precipitation during the winter months is more than an inch of snow or ice is on the trail, the story will not be switched out.
